Dear Colleagues and Friends,

It is my pleasure and honor to welcome you to the 7th congress of the European Society for the Study of Personality Disorders, in Antwerp (Belgium) on "Treating Personality Pathology in a Time of Change".

Treatment of personality pathology has changed over the past generations of researchers and clinicians. Treatment contexts present challenges and opportunities due to evolving diagnostic classifications, emerging needs in specific populations – including youth and families -, constraints related to dissemination of good practice principles across the globe, the increased use of technology to treat clients, and the more active - and warmly welcomed - involvement of users and carers in the treatment. While no existence is conceivable without change, and no life without change - change is truly omnipresent -, change is also fundamentally elusive. Change may not always be visible to our naked eyes, nor to our fMRI scanner nor time-lagged prediction models, but it is there. Small changes in the context of a client's narrative may have a huge impact on the meaning of the story and the interaction they are engaged in. Change impacts us humans in various ways: we talk about desirable changes if clients get better and reclaim their lives, and about undesirable or harmful changes when a war starts. Change as context affects the treatment delivered to our clients, while change in context transforms the client's presenting problem into unchartered territory of self-knowledge, nourishing interpersonal relationships and a new story of a lifetime.

The topic of "Treating personality pathology in a time of change" necessarily involves multiple perspectives. Not only researchers from a variety of theoretical backgrounds, but also practitioners and clients should get a voice at ESSPD 2024 to explain, demonstrate and witness the groundbreaking change clients can make in treatments. Yet, no perspective can describe it all. Therefore this year, for our plenary and other sessions, we have composed groups of experts to debate and dialogue on facets of change in the domain

of personality disorders, in the hope that the emerging discussion truly moves into territory that is unchartered, truly stimulates astute researchers to study hitherto overlooked phenomena, truly supports caring therapists in their desire to help with even more powerful means, and truly recognizes and supports the bold work our students and early-career researchers are engaged in.

The Flemish city of Antwerp is the perfect place to study change this year, to learn from each other and to celebrate our first get-together since 2018. A light-hearted – rather small – city with an open heart, featuring numerous places to have Belgian beer, and even more, so it seems to me, riders of bicycles. It seems to me that Carpe Diem has been coined right here at the shores of river Schelde, where open hands welcome you to come to a halt, appreciate life, while at the same time pushing the boundaries of our knowledge on personality pathology.


